What is Animation?

- Animation is the process of creating moving pieces of artwork.
- That is taking 2D images and creating subtle changes to create movement.

Why is animation important?

• Animation is important as it provides another medium in media that can be used to convey a message.

When is animation useful?

- Anytime a person is using media an animation can be used to get the audiences attention.
- Animations are also useful when a single 2D image does not represent something
 - For example, if a picture shows a person with their hand in the air, that does not show that they are actually waving their hand as it is only a single image.


• Animations in PPT are quite simple, but this is our starting point.

Animations in PPT: Create a PPT then follow the steps


• Step one choose a shape




• Step two choose another shape




• Step three open animations from the ribbon




• Step four create an entrance effect for both shapes




• Step five create an emphasis effect for both shapes




• Step six create a path animation for both shapes
