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## Dividing Fractions

$$1) \quad \frac{6}{10} \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{6 \times 2}{10 \times 1} = \frac{12}{10} = \frac{6}{5} = 1\frac{1}{5}$$

$$2) \quad \frac{3}{4} \div \frac{1}{3} = \frac{3 \times 3}{4 \times 1} = \frac{9}{4} = 2\frac{1}{4}$$

$$3) \quad \frac{3}{4} \div \frac{4}{5} = \frac{3 \times 5}{4 \times 4} = \frac{15}{16}$$

$$4) \quad \frac{1}{4} \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{1 \times 2}{4 \times 1} = \frac{2}{4} = \frac{1}{2}$$

$$5) \quad \frac{2}{4} \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{2 \times 2}{4 \times 1} = \frac{4}{4} = 1$$

$$6) \quad \frac{1}{3} \div \frac{2}{5} = \frac{1 \times 5}{3 \times 2} = \frac{5}{6}$$

$$7) \quad \frac{1}{2} \div \frac{8}{10} = \frac{1 \times 10}{2 \times 8} = \frac{10}{16} = \frac{5}{8}$$

$$8) \quad \frac{1}{10} \div \frac{1}{5} = \frac{1 \times 5}{10 \times 1} = \frac{5}{10} = \frac{1}{2}$$

$$9) \quad \frac{4}{5} \div \frac{1}{3} = \frac{4 \times 3}{5 \times 1} = \frac{12}{5} = 2\frac{2}{5}$$

$$10) \quad \frac{1}{5} \div \frac{2}{3} = \frac{1 \times 3}{5 \times 2} = \frac{3}{10}$$
