Marking Criteria

 - a. All pages must link back to this page

 - a. Must have at least two (2) pages (not including the index page)
 - b. In those two (2) pages the following content needs to be included (These are the nine (9) PLOs as well as examples of when they were addressed in class)
 1. **digital and non-digital** media technologies, their distinguishing characteristics and uses
 - short story
 - comic strip
 - Web Design (websites)
 2. techniques for organizing ideas to structure information and story through media **conventions**
 - Billboards

 - Bullying and Cyberbullying
