Welcome to Textiles 9! Over the next 2.5 months, we will explore a variety of concepts related to Textiles. Textiles 9 is the foundation for Textiles 10 and consecutive Textiles courses.

- Elements of design used in the design of a textile item
- Social factors that influence textile choices and the impact of those choices on local communities
- Role of textiles in First Peoples cultures
