- Please ensure that all materials are clean before using them, if anything is dirty wash it first before using it
 - Measuring cups/spoons
 - Cutlery including knives, spoons and forks
 - Etcetera

 Wash down counters before placing anything on them

 Wash down table before placing anything on them.

HYGIENE

- when it comes to the hygiene rules we must realize that as a community dinner we need to ensure the following
 - Washing your hands regularly
 - Blowing noses away from food area and washing hands
 - Cough or sneeze into your elbow or shoulder avoiding food areas
 - Long hair needs to be braided back tightly to prevent hair from entering food.
